Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. How do I go about registering my child for the competition?

Ans: A Google document is available via the Staccato! Facebook/website. Do note that applications and payments will close on 31 Oct 2026 and late submissions will not be entertained.

2. What is the difference between the Competitive and the Non-Competitive category?

Ans: The non-competitive category is designed to be friendlier. It is a recommended option for young musicians who are taking part in their first ever competition. There are no prerequisites. Repertoire is free choice, and no memorisation of repertoire is necessary. Participants will be evaluated solely on the basis of their performance, and they will be awarded participation medallions as a result.

The competitive category participants will be graded according to the following rubrics.

Gold Award: 90-100%

Silver Award: 80-89%

Bronze Award: 70-79%

Participation Awards: <69%

The top scoring Competitive Category participant of each category will be invited to play in the concert on 29 Nov 2026.

3. My child plays two instruments. Can we submit just one application?

Ans: No, you will need to submit TWO separate application forms. However, you can register one instrument under the Non-Competitive category and the other under the Competitive category based on your child's abilities.

4. What are the requirements on videos to be submitted?

Ans: For the Competitive category, videos have to be recorded in a single take. Merged videos are not permitted. The videos for the Non-Competitive category ARE allowed to be merged. For both categories, the candidate's hands, fingers, and face should be clearly visible at all times. Both portrait and landscape oriented videos are permitted.

5. How do I go about paying the application fees?

Ans: We accept Paynow, and bank transfer of fees. Payment method is to be indicated on the Google form.

Proof of payment is to be emailed to info@staccato.com.sg by 31 Oct 2026. Acknowledgement of payment will be sent within THREE working days of receipt. Please note that incomplete applications will not be processed. Application fees are not refundable or transferrable.

6. Can my child participate in both Competitive and Non-Competitive categories?

Ans: Yes, he/she can. He/she can even use the same repertoire for both categories. However, do note that the repertoire for the Competitive category has to be memorised and no book or score should be visible during the recording.

7. When will results be released?

Ans: All participants will receive an email with their results as well as instructions for collection of certificates/participation medallions. Prize winners for the Competitive category will be contacted directly because they will be performing in the concert on 29 Nov 2026. Results will also be released via the Staccato! Facebook and website on 10 Nov 2026. Judges' decisions will be final, and no appeals will be entertained.

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
